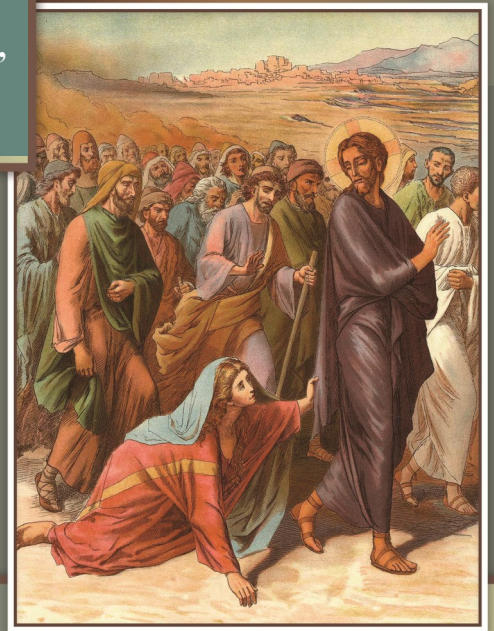

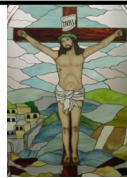

WHAT IS THE 11th/12th GRADE CLASS LIKE?

Youth who participate in this class move into the format used for Adult Formation— That is the participants choose what topics and activities they want to do. When the class meets for the first time, participants tell the catechists which teachings/topics interest them and help to set the syllabus for the year. For example: Relationships with parents, friends, girl/boyfriends and how to manage them; How to live a Catholic life today; Preparing for college/ workplace; Money Management for Young Adults; Church teachings and action on human dignity, homelessness, poverty, hunger, etc. The catechists have several resources available to help you explore the topics chosen and how to incorporate them into their lives. All youth who have been Confirmed are welcome to join this class, which will meet after the 11:30 Mass on Sundays. 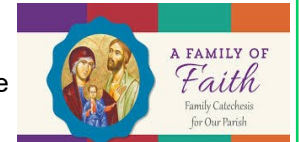

Though a simple act, registration is a sign of one's commitment and responsibility to the parish and allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your **Active membership** and is **essential for participation** in parish programs and sacraments.

What is an **Active Membership**? Three points determine active membership:

- **Registration in the parish for a sufficient period of time and use of the envelope system in support of the parish;**
- **Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days;**
- **Volunteer and participate in Parish activities with time, talent, and treasure as means permit.**

Please note: The Facilities and Services of Good Shepherd Church are available to active members.

Sick and Homebound/Hospitalized: Please notify the Parish Office when someone is ill and unable to attend Mass for any significant length of time and would like to receive Holy Communion.

Bulletin Deadline: Requests must be received 10 days **prior** to the weekend the announcement is to be published. E-mail your request to: gbulletinedit@gmail.com.

Special Needs: Handicapped accessible doors are located on the left side of the Gathering Area.

Wheelchair seating is available in the front row of **chairs** in the Church. Cars must display a valid handicap sticker or placard to park in the reserved handicap spaces in the Church parking lot.

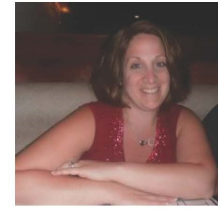

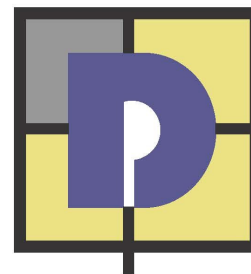
