High school seniors must also include one (1) letter of academic recommendation from a current teacher or school administrator or coach. The recommendation cannot be from a relative.

All applicants must provide one (1) letter of character reference from an adult (over 18 years of age) who is not related to the applicant. Each applicant must submit three (3) letters total: clergy, academic, and character.
